

Town of Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry NON-DISCRIMINATION/TITLE VI

Title VI and Nondiscrimination Commitment (FHWA):

Pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related laws and regulations, Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry will not exclude from participation or deny the benefits of, or subject to discrimination anyone on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability.

Title VI and Nondiscrimination Commitment (FTA):

Pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related laws and regulations, Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry will not exclude from participation or deny the benefits of, or subject to discrimination anyone on the grounds of race, color and national origin.

Complaint Procedures:

The Town of Cranberry Isles has established a discrimination complaint procedure and will take prompt and reasonable action to investigate and eliminate discrimination when found. Any person who believes that he or she has been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the Town of Cranberry Isles. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the Cranberry Isles Town Office within sixty (60) calendar days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence. ADA/504 Statement:

Pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) and related federal and state laws and regulations, Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry will make every effort to ensure that its facilities and services are accessible to those with disabilities. Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry will provide reasonable accommodation to disabled individuals who require special assistance to access Cranberry Isles Commuter Ferry facilities and services. Because providing reasonable accommodation may require outside assistance, organization or resources, Cranberry Isles Town Office asks that requests be made at least five (5) calendar days prior to the need for accommodation. Questions, concerns, comments or requests for accommodation should be made to the Cranberry Isles Town Office.

Services are provided free without charge for individuals with special needs with disabilities. Any fees will be paid by the recipient or sub-recipient. The public will have access to translators, "I Speak Cards", TTY/TDD services and vital documents translated when requested
